

DYMO Label Software (DLS) Version 7.7

Platform

- Mac OS 10.2.8 or later
- Support for OS X ONLY through direct USB connection
- Note: If you are not running Mac OS X, please return to the Drivers and Downloads page and select DYMO Label Software Application Version 5.0.5 for Mac OS 8.6 to Mac OS 9.x

System Requirements

- 15 MB of hard disk space
- 8 MB of available RAM
- Open USB port
- CD ROM or Internet connectivity
- A 300 or 400 series LabelWriter, LabelManager PC II, LabelManager 450, or a LabelPoint 350.

Summary of Changes (From Version 7.6 to Version 7.7)

- Improved Printer Installation.

Summary of Changes (From Version 7.5 to Version 7.6)

- DLS 7.6 is a Universal Binary Release.
- New Add-in for Microsoft Excel. The Add-in is automatically installed when you install DLS and you have Microsoft Office 2004 or X already installed.
- Updated documentation. More information is now provided about printing to shared printers and print servers over the network in the online Help.
- Improved Printer Installation – After the software installation is complete, just plug in a new printer and it will automatically install. The exception is the LabelWriter Duo and the older 300 series printers. Those printers must be added through the Print Center/Printer Setup Utility.

- Support for the new ExecuLabel LM450 and ExecuLabel LP350 tape printers.
- Text object automatically added when creating a new label template.

Installation Instructions

DLS requires that you have Mac OS X "Administrator" level permissions to install a printer. You **MUST** be able to modify files in the System folder to install and configure a LabelWriter printer.

***NOTE:** Do not connect the USB cable to your computer or USB hub until instructed to do so during the software installation. If you have a label printer already installed, disconnect the USB cable from your computer before running this installer and reconnect the cable when instructed to do so.*

Manually Installing a Label Printer (other than the LabelWriter Duo printer)

If you do not connect the label printer when asked to do so during the software installation or if you have problems with the printer installation, follow these instructions to add the printer manually:

1. Make sure your label printer is plugged in and turned on before continuing.
2. Open the Print Center/Printer Setup Utility. The Print Center/Printer Setup Utility is located in the **Applications>Utilities** folder on your hard disk.
3. In the Print Center/Printer Setup Utility, click **Add**.
4. Select the **label printer** from the list of choices in the Printer List and click **Add**. The printer is added to the printer list.
5. Close the Print Center/Printer Setup Utility to complete the installation.

Manually Installing the LabelWriter Duo Printer

The LabelWriter Duo printer appears as two separate printers in the Printer Browser: **DYMO DUO Tape** (or **DYMO DUO Tape 128**) and **DYMO DUO Label**. You need to install each of these printers separately.

1. Make sure your label printer is plugged in and turned on before continuing.
2. Open the Print Center/Printer Setup Utility. The Print Center/Printer Setup Utility is located in the **Applications>Utilities** folder on your hard disk.
3. In the Print Center/Printer Setup Utility, click **Add**. You may see the label printer(s) listed in the printer list but the **Add** button will not be available.
4. In Mac OS 10.4: click **More Printers** and select **DYMO DUO USB** from the drop-down list at the top of the Printers List dialog box.
In Mac OS 10.2.8 – Mac OS 10.3.9: select **DYMO DUO USB** from the drop-down list.
5. Select **DYMO DUO Label** from the list of printers and click **Add**.
6. Repeat steps 3 through 5 to add **DYMO DUO Tape** (or **DYMO DUO Tape 128**).

The LabelWriter Duo printer appears as two separate printers in the Printer list: **DYMO DUO Tape** (or **DYMO DUO Tape 128**) and **DYMO DUO Label**. You need to install each of these printers separately.

LabelWriter Duo Notes

- The LabelWriter Duo printer does not support Rendezvous/Bonjour. You will not be able to locate a LabelWriter Duo printer with Rendezvous/Bonjour.
- Printing to both the LabelWriter Duo Tape and Label printers at the same time is not recommended.

***NOTE:** In some cases, you may not see your printer model listed in the Printer Setup utility or the **Add** button may be disabled. If this occurs, exit and restart the Printer Setup Utility.*

LabelWriter Duo Notes

Microsoft Office X and 2004

To use DYMO LabelWriter Add-in for Microsoft Office X and 2004, you must have Microsoft Office Service Pack 1 installed. If you do not have Service Pack 1 installed, you will not be able to see the LabelWriter icon in the Word toolbar. You can download the latest Service Pack for Microsoft Word, free of charge, from the Microsoft Web site.

Microsoft Excel

The Excel Add-in preview feature is not supported on Mac OS versions prior to 10.4 or on Microsoft Excel for Office X.

Special Instructions and Important Notes

- If you are upgrading from DLS 6, you may want to consider backing up the following folders before installing DLS 7:
 - o Address Books
 - o Label Files
- Label templates and Address Book files created in DLS 6 are compatible with DLS 7.
- If you have a LabelWriter 300 series printer, you must remove the printer and then add it back in the Print Center/Printer Setup Utility to make sure you have all the latest label sizes available.
- This version of DLS supports LabelWriter 300 and 400 series printers. Earlier printer models are **NOT** supported.
